Following the success of the 1<sup>st</sup> Alder Hey Paediatric Vestibular Study Day, we are delighted to announce the 2<sup>nd</sup> Alder Hey Paediatric Vestibular Course exploring the different aspects of the paediatric vestibular system. The course is aimed at clinicians in any discipline involved with paediatric balance. The course is open to a national and an international audience.
