Values and Principles

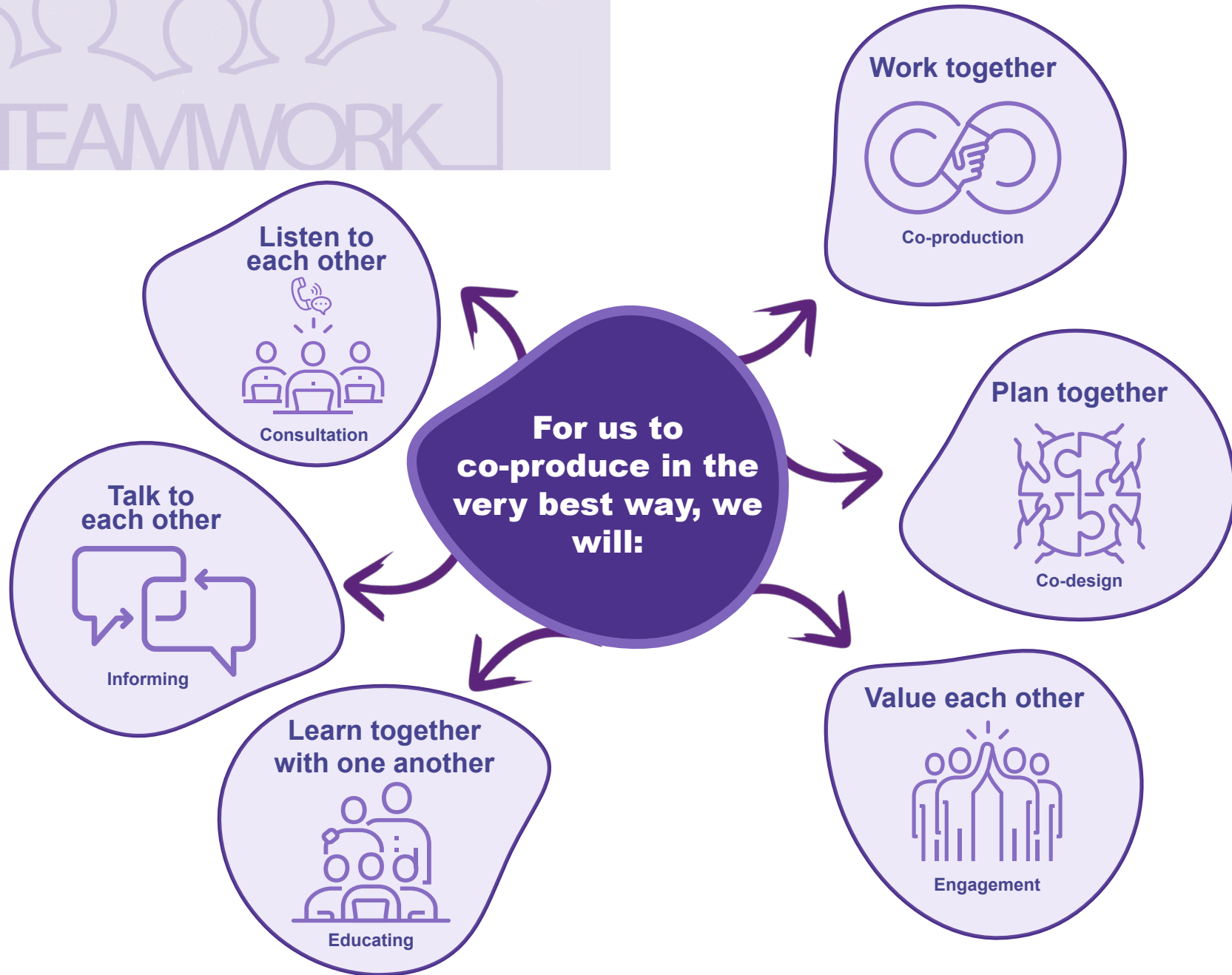
