**Information for parents and carers**

The fact sheet aims to provide you with information about a nursing service provided to patients and their families. If you have any queries or wish to speak to a member of the team about the service please ring the telephone number overleaf.

**What is the Children's Community Nursing Team (CCNT)?**

The CCNT comprises of a team of experienced children's nurses. The team provides nursing care for children and young people in their own home or within a community setting.

**Why are children and young people referred to CCNT?**

Children and young people will have been referred to the CCNT service for nursing support within the community setting.

**Do the CCNT provide care and treatment to all patients?**

The team see children and young people aged 0-16 years who have a nursing need in Liverpool, Knowsley and South Sefton.

**What are the CCNT aims?**

- To provide a service that enables children to be nursed at home with their family or guardian.
- To reduce hospital admission and to shorten the time spent in hospital.
- To work closely with other professionals.
- To provide training to nursery staff, school staff, carers and other agencies.

**When is the service available to provide care and treatment patients?**

The nurses in CCNT work in shifts from 7.30am to 10.00pm, seven days a week

**Where is the CCNT based?**

The CCNT have their offices in Alder Hey Hospital in Liverpool
