**Subject:** Usage of laryngeal mask for surgical procedures

- Q1 What types of surgical procedures do you use the laryngeal mask in?
- A1 We use laryngeal masks for a number of different procedures, including:
  - a. Orthopaedic fractures, nailing / plating etc
  - b. Manipulations under anaesthetic
  - c. Plastic surgical repairs of nerves / tendons.
  - d. Gynaecomastia etc
  - e. Removal of lesions/ scar revisions
  - f. General surgery, non abdominal cavity operations such as orchidopexy /colonoscopy
  - g. Dental removal / restoration of teeth.
  - h. Laser surgery to skin
  - i. Oncology intrathecal injections
  - j. ENT Grommet insertion
  - k. MRI scans
  - I. Interventional Radiology sclerotherapy
