CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE WITH SEVERE MENTAL **HEALTH ISSUES NOW HAVE FANTASTIC NEW FACILITIES** TO SUPPORT THEIR CARE AND **RECOVERY AT SUNFLOWER** HOUSE, THE NEW INPATIENT UNIT, NOW OPEN AT ALDER HEY.

The urgent and growing crisis in mental health has increased demand for specialist inpatient care, as well as other mental health services. Sunflower House is for those aged 5 to 13 years old from across the North who have the most challenging mental health conditions.

Child A's\* life was saved by Alder Hey after they tried to end their life three times before eventually being diagnosed with autism and an eating disorder. Child A's mum said:



Alder Hey Children's Charity has raised £3m towards Sunflower House, to create a homely feel and deliver state of the art treatments for the children and young people there.

### INTRODUCING DANIEL CASSON. GOVERNOR FOR THE REST OF ENGLAND

HELLO, I'M DANIEL AND HAVE **BEEN A GOVERNOR AT ALDER** HEY FOR FOUR YEARS AND HAVE LOVED EVERY SECOND OF MY ROLE.

I am from Manchester and have lived in London for the past 30 years. I moved there after coming back from Egypt where I had been working as a translator/interpreter.



My brother, David, was a paediatric gastroenterologist at Alder Hey. He died in 2009 from stomach cancer when he was 45: he loved Alder Hey, and, as a Mancunian, he took Liverpool to his heart. When the opportunity came to put myself up for election as The Rest of England Governor, I jumped at the chance. I am determined to help the children and families he loved working with. He would not recognise Alder Hey in its current physical regeneration, but he would recognise the community spirit which makes this place so special.

Many parts of what we do at Alder Hey reinforce community, and I see Alder Hey as a main building block of local community. The most recent expression of this is the opening of Sunflower House, our new on site mental health unit, housed in the new community 'Catkin' building. The whole ethos of Sunflower House and the Catkin building is to create better medium and long-term outcomes for people in the community.


#### **HOEDOWN:**


