Update to response as per IR request:

The Trust has decided to uphold its original decision to advise "There has been no training courses carried out by the Trust or on Trust premises in relation to trans children and young people or children and young people with any of gender dysphoria, gender incongruence, gender distress or gender related distress in the last 6 months." This is factually correct.

However, we would like to make it clear that training for the Trust's staff for the new Children and Young People's Gender Service (North) was commissioned by NHS England. The provider was the Academy of Medical Royal Colleges and was conducted in Birmingham and London. No course materials were provided as part of the training provided by the Academy of Medical Royal Colleges. The training was provided face to face in the format of a presentation.
