Subject: Skin Cancer Treatment Times

- Q1 The number of patients who were on a waiting list at your Trust to start treatment following an urgent referral for any type of skin cancer for the each of the following financial years a) 2019/2020, b) 2020/21, c) 2021/22, d) 2022/2023 e) 2023/24
- A1 The trust has not received any diagnosis of cancer after an urgent referral for a possible skin cancer. The trust has also not started any treatment for any skin cancers.

To further clarify, the Trust do get referrals for skin lesions, which are directed to plastics and dermatology for initial consultation. The Trust may start a diagnostic process but if a diagnosis is made the patient is referred to the skin MDT at Bridgewater. If anti-cancer therapy treatment is required for under 16's they would be referred back to the Trust under the direction of the skin MDT and they would remain involved and direct therapy. However, this process is very rare and unusual as it is not common to see skin cancer in children.
